## **Purposes:**

To provide guidance to officers and members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation in the execution of their fiduciary duties on behalf of the Corporation

## **Policy:**

The Board of Directors of the Emerson Health System are responsible for:

- Setting the mission, vision, strategic plan and core values, defining the ends, goals and priorities of the organization.
- A duty of care overseeing the hospitals/s financial health and sustainability.
- Adopting policies and making decisions to advance organizational objectives and goals.
- Overseeing the credentialing process making sure that healthcare professionals have the proper training, licensing, and accreditation.
- Selecting the CEO, establishing his or her goals and expectations, evaluating the CEO's performance and establishing/reviewing the CEO's compensation to reward excellent performance.
- Monitoring the organization's performance against board-established goals, especially measurable targets for mission, finances, strategic direction and quality.
- Using contacts and influence with key internal and external constituencies to advance the mission and vision.
- Taking responsibility for the board's own effectiveness, including conducting regular self-evaluation of the board.
