Emerson Hospital created the Bethke Cancer Center in 1997 to bring outstanding cancer specialists and facilities to the community in a convenient, personalized setting. The Center provides state-of-the-art technology and addresses the personal and physical needs of each patient and family confronting cancer.

Radiation oncology services are delivered by the Massachusetts General Hospital Department of Radiation Oncology at Emerson Hospital. Medical oncology services are provided in collaboration with Commonwealth Hematology-Oncology medical group. Bethke Cancer Center patients are able to enroll in clinical trials sponsored by the National Cancer Institute, thus providing these patients access to promising experimental therapies. Through affiliations with MGH, Brigham and Women's Hospital, Lahey Clinic and others, Emerson Hospital cancer patients also have access to additional resources, including specialized treatment, whenever necessary.
